Poverty Reduction Briefing 2016. No. 9 (March 21-31, 2016)

State and Ministerial Policy News:

On the meeting held by the State Council Leading Group Office of Poverty Alleviation and Development, Vice Premier Wang Yang stressed that "We should earnestly study and implement the principles set out in a series of important speeches on poverty alleviation and development given by President Xi, and endeavor to reach the goal of shaking off poverty for 10 million people in rural areas, with quality and quantity guaranteed."

On Mar 22nd, 2016, "Opinions on Implementing Poverty Alleviation Driven by Financial Aid" was jointly released by the People's Bank of China, National Development & Reform Commission, the Ministry of Finance, China Banking Regulatory Commission, China Securities Regulatory Commission, China Insurance Regulatory Commission and the State Council Leading Group Office of Poverty Alleviation and Development. The Opinions made specific arrangements for financial poverty alleviation, including reloaning to people enjoying poverty-alleviation aids and properly increasing the tolerance for non-performing loans.

Local Poverty Alleviation News:

In 2015, Yibin City, Sichuan Province lifted 68,700 people out of poverty. In 2015, the number of rural residents of Yibin City relieved from poverty reached

68,700, which accounts for 105.45% of the expected number. It is planned that 66,617 people will shake off poverty and 19,100 people will be resettled for poverty alleviation in 2016.

During the period of "The Twelfth Five-Year Plan", 64,365 people in Napo County, Baise City, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region were lifted out of poverty. During the period of "The Twelfth Five-Year Plan", Napo County attached great importance to infrastructure construction projects, including the renovation of dilapidated houses, the improvement of transportation and the access to safe drinking water, electricity, televisions, methane tanks and so on. Per capita net income of the rural residents has risen from 3,042 RMB in 2011 to 4,962 RMB in 2015, with an annual average growth rate of 13%, and the poverty incidence has thus dropped from 62.7% to 26.8%.

A total of 21,000 people in Anyuan County, Jiangxi Province were lifted out of poverty. By March 2016, 18 poverty-stricken villages in Anyuan County have got rid of poverty through measures such as developing cyclic planting and breeding industry and countryside tourism via joint stock with companies. With such efforts, 21,000 people have shaken off poverty, lowering the poverty incidence by around 6.7%.

A total of 28,000 people in Tanchang County, Gansu Province have been lifted out poverty since 2015. Tanchang County, since 2015, has been vigorously developing e-commerce poverty alleviation pilots with 296 online shops newly established, the total number of online shops reaching 957 and online sales generating a total profit of 99.25 million RMB. By emphasizing on the implementation of the preferential agricultural policies, the local government has allocated 370 million RMB as poverty alleviation loans to 7,657 poverty-stricken households. With such efforts, 28,000 people from 24 key disadvantaged villages have stepped out of poverty.

Public Poverty Alleviation and Charity News:

General Office of Guizhou Provincial People's Government released "One Household One Person-A Three-Year (2015-2017) Plan for Poverty Alleviation in Innovative Vocational Education and Training", and selected one hundred vocational schools as poverty alleviation bases in collaboration with departments in charge of education, human resources and social security and poverty alleviation. During the following three years since 2015, 10 qualified provincial vocational schools will hold annually the "Wei Ning Class" and the "He Zhang Class" for free, with aim to cultivate 6,000 students, whose employment will help 6,000 families to shake off poverty.
